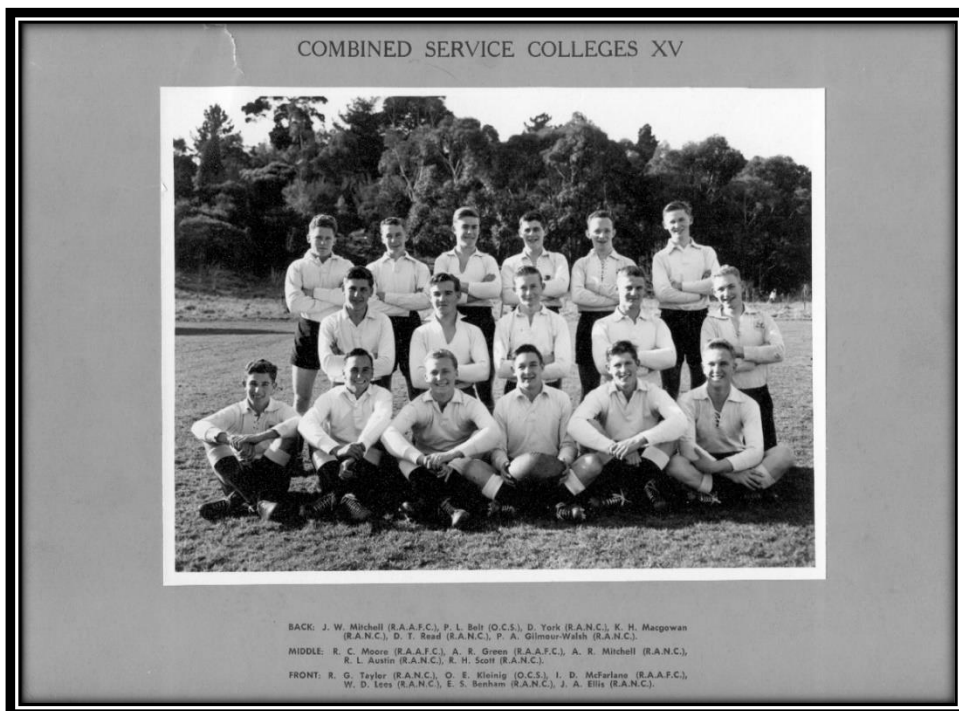

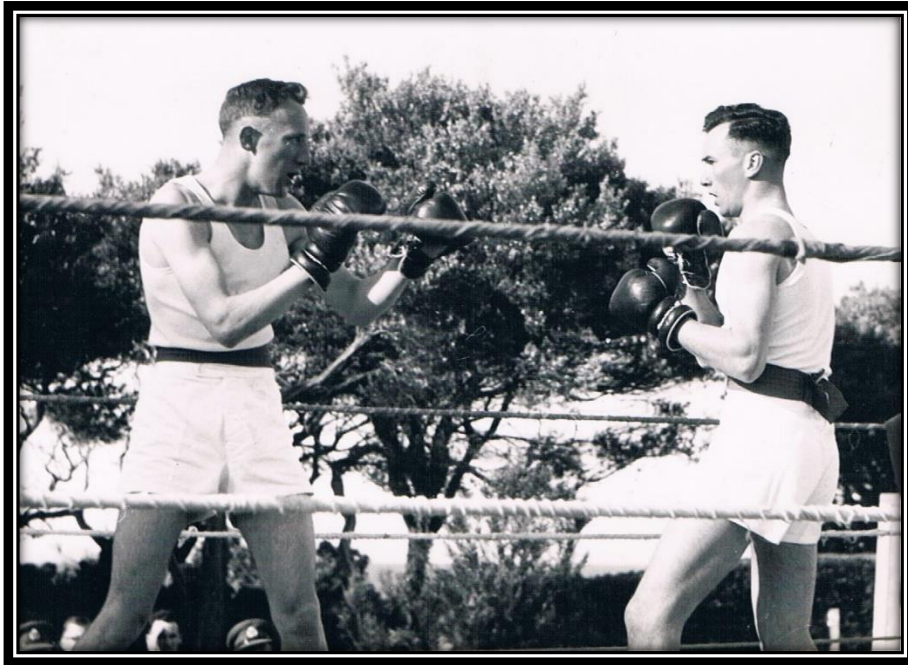

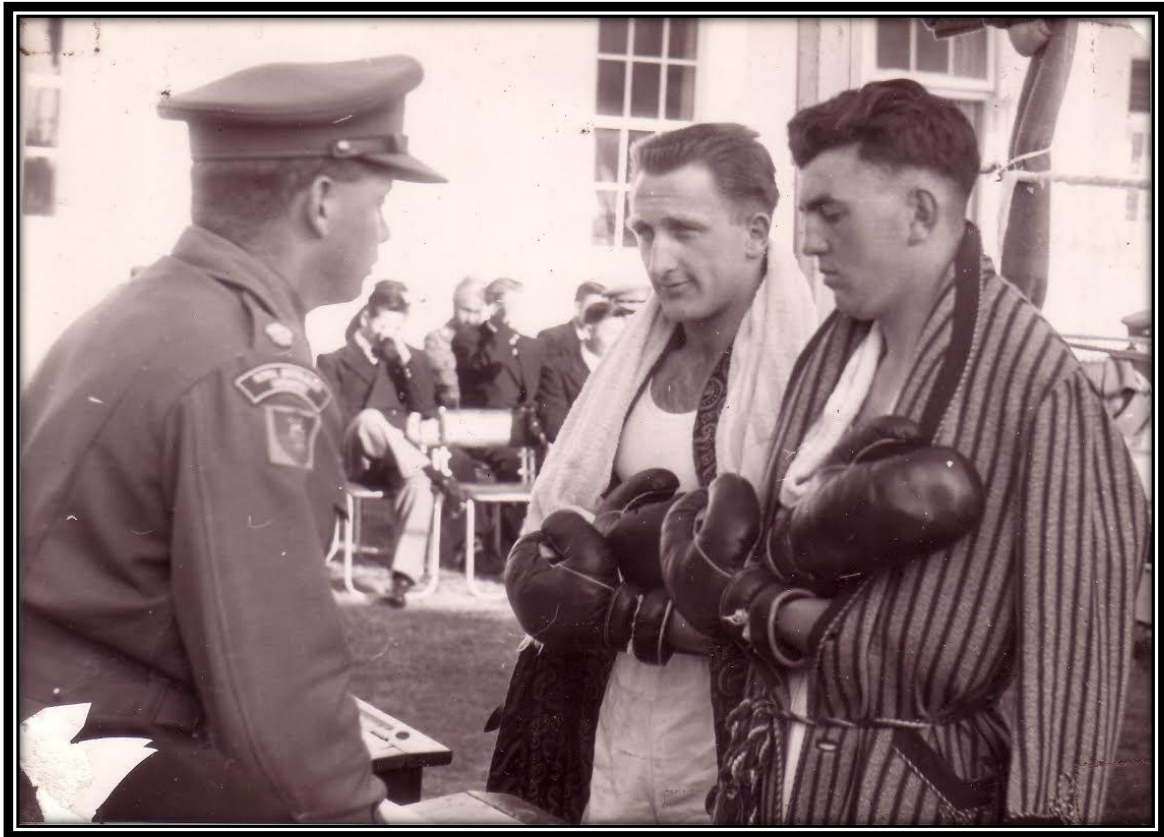

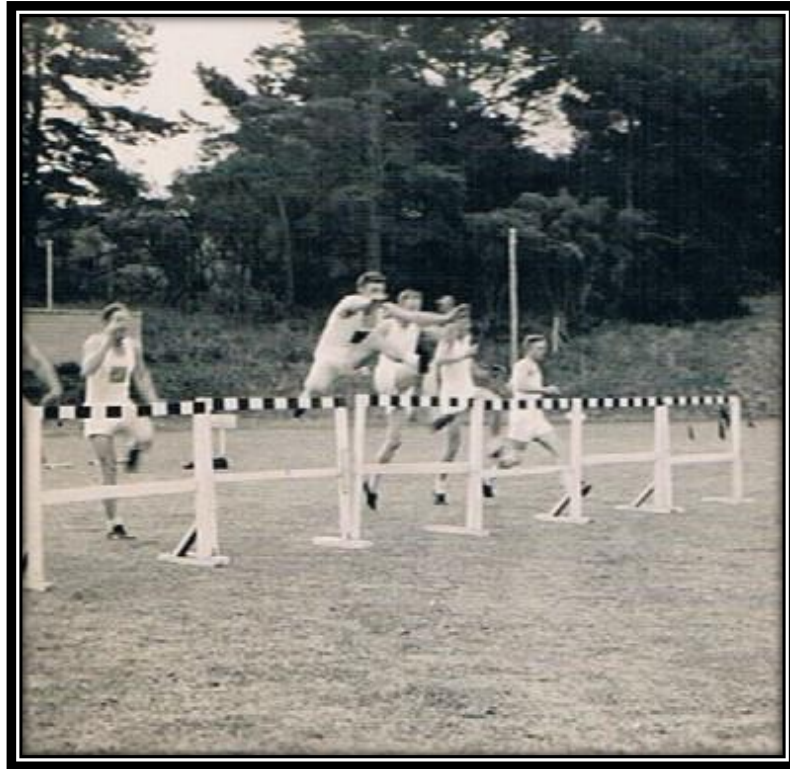

This building is the Hospital and was used as the Sergeants Mess for the first month or so.

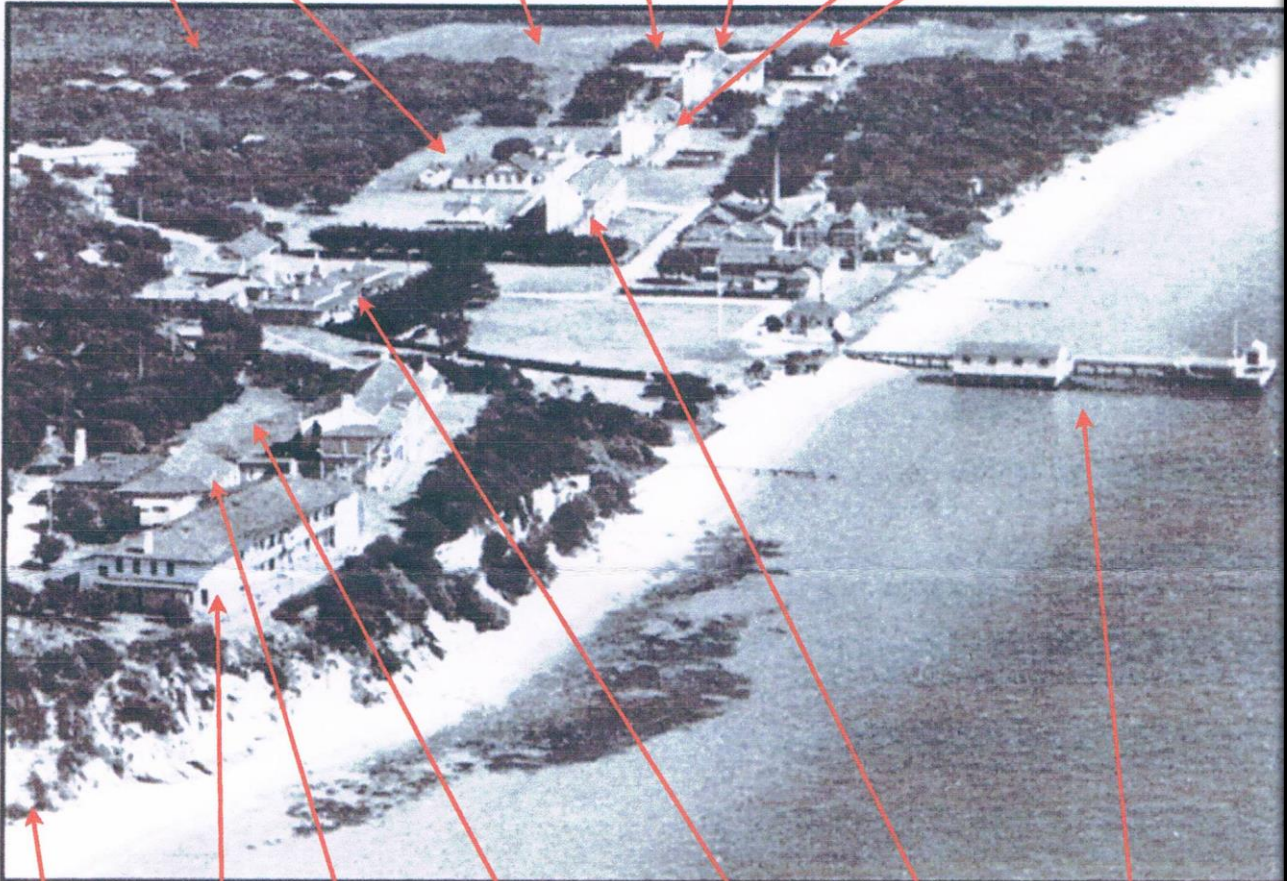

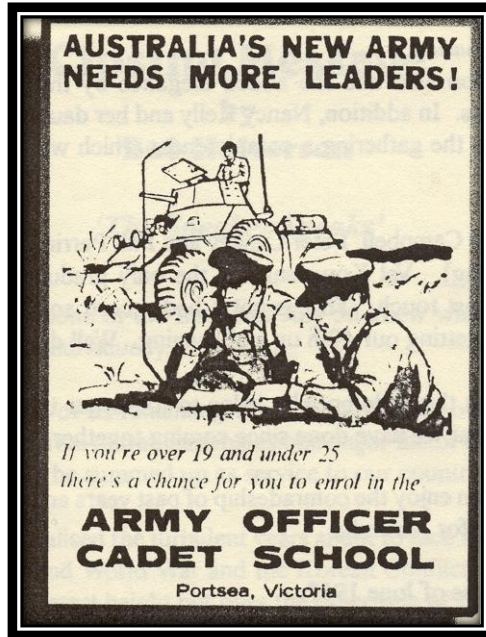

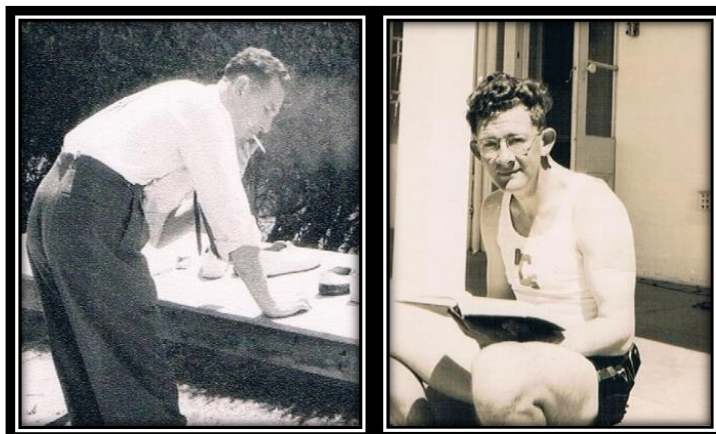

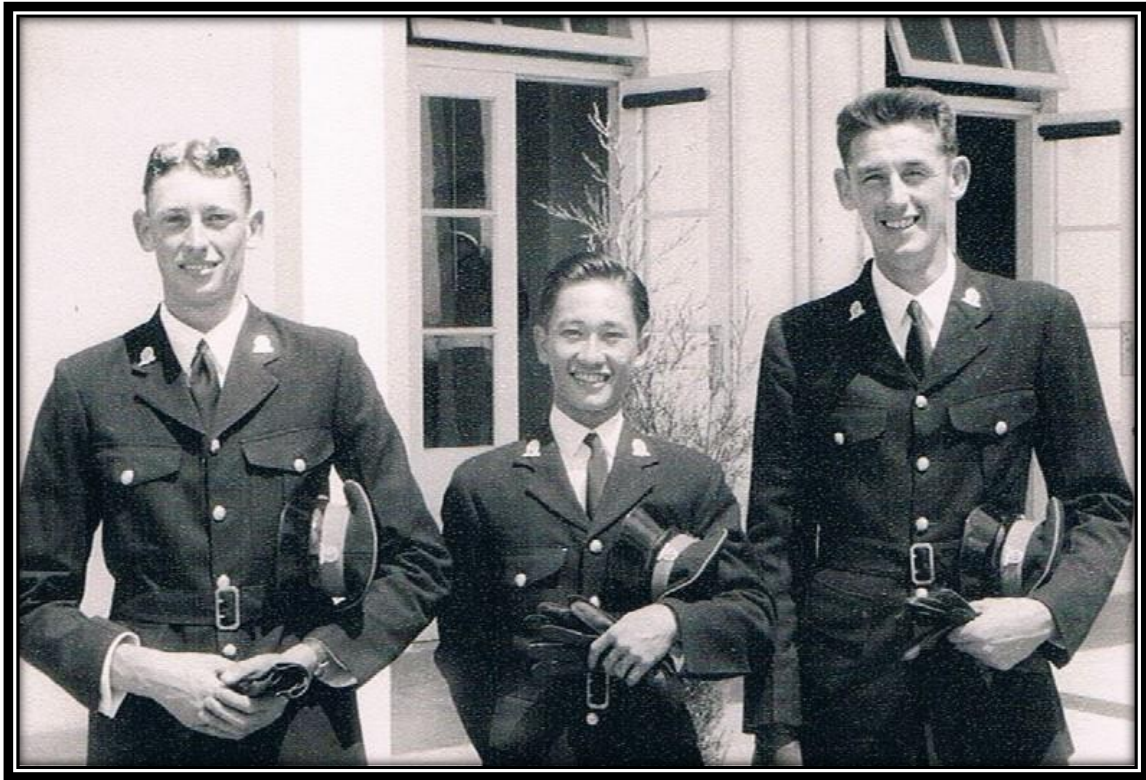

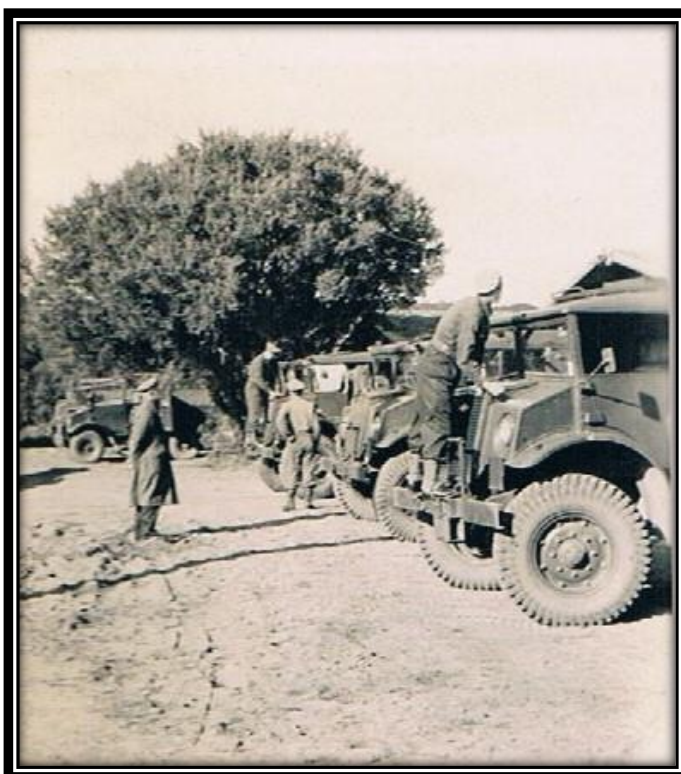

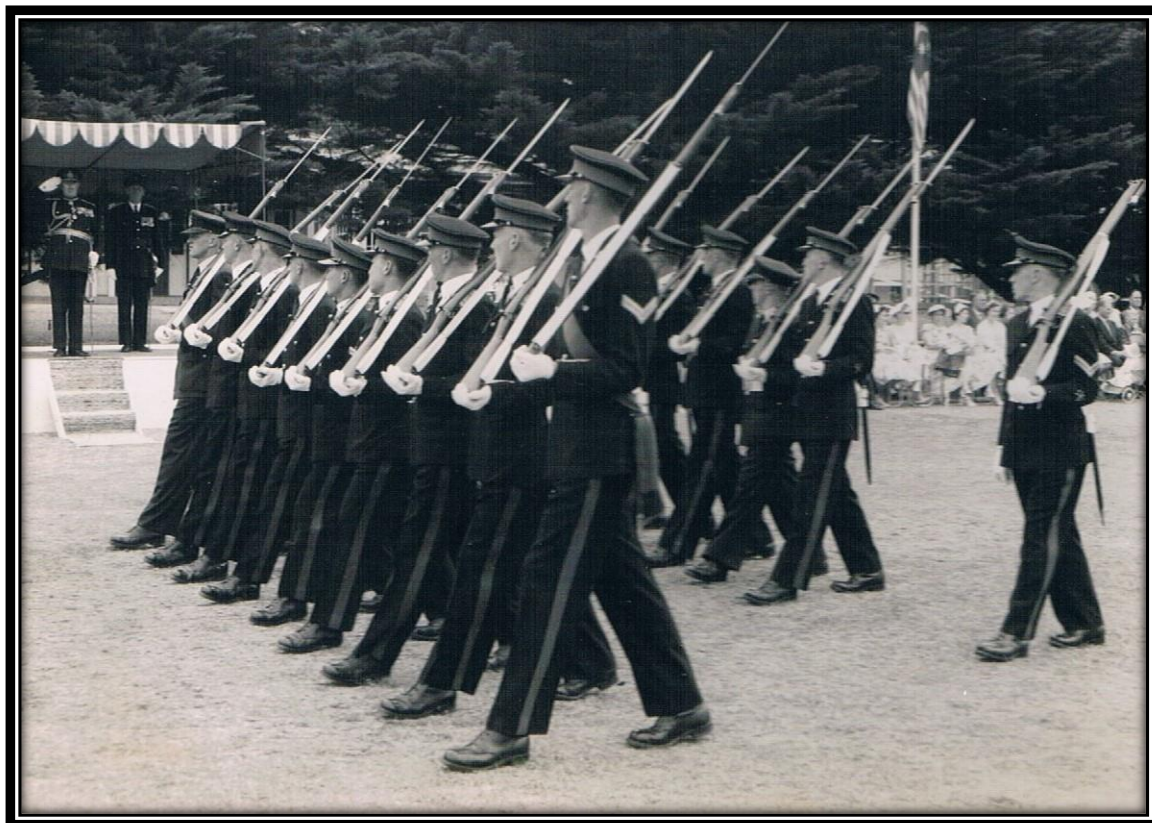

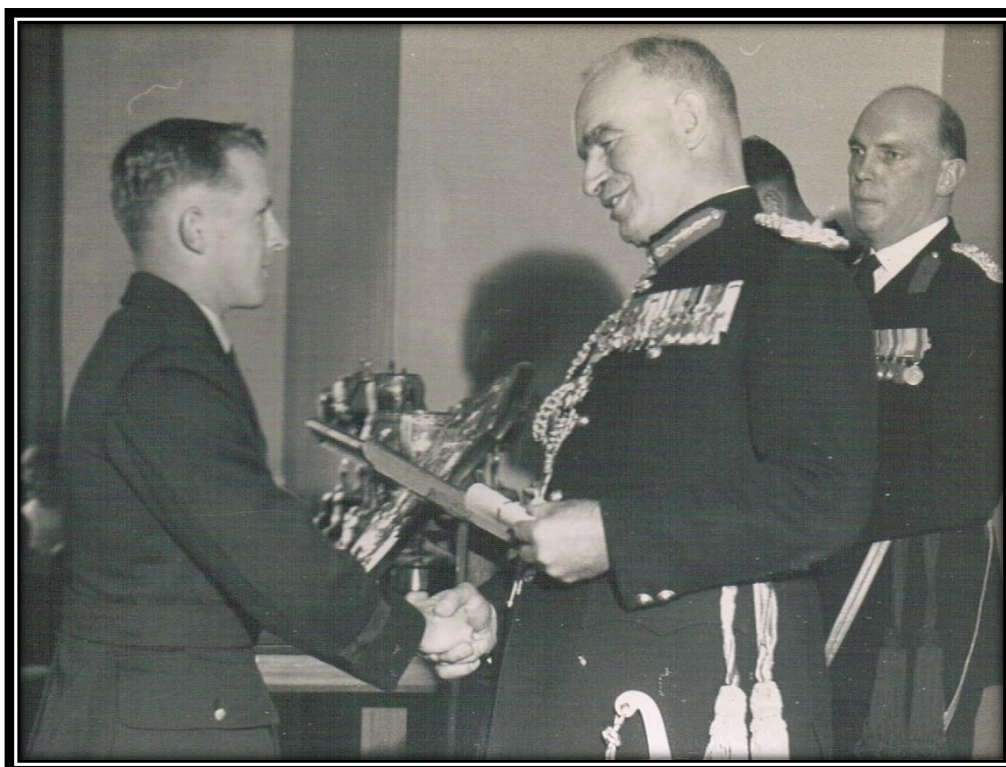

# Young officers graduate at Portsea cadet school parade

Three overseas nationalities were represented at the Officers' Cadet School, Portsea, graduation last Thursday, when thirty-four officer cadets passed out to postings in various sections of the Australian army.

They included four Malayan, five New Zealand, three R.A.A.F. and twenty-two army graduates under command of C.S.M. A. W. Ancell, the first New Zealand graduate to hold the appointment.

It was New Zealand's day as the Reviewing Officer was Major-General C. E. Weir, C.B., C.B.E., D.S.O., Chief of the General Staff, New Zealand, who later addressed graduates and guests and presented diplomas, prizes and trophies.

The outside parade left nothing to be desired in military precision, discipline and training.

To music of Southern Command Band the graduating class and junior class marched on to the parade march past in slow and quick time.

Moving ceremony as a finale was the traditional movement of farewell by junior class to the graduating cadets who, to the strains of "Auld Lang Syne" marched in slow time through the ranks of the junior class and off the parade.

### PROUD MOMENTS

The lecture room was the scene of many moving and proud moments as parents, relatives and sweethearts sat to witness the presentations, report by the Commandant Colonel D. R. Jackson, D.S.O., and address by Major-General Weir.

Presenting his report Colonel Jackson said the graduating class was a good class—good because they had made themselves so through initiative and teamwork.

He pointed out that within the school the four great religions of the world had worked together in harmony and had presented no problem.

He paid special tribute to staff members for their support and hard work with particular reference to Dr. Camm and ministers of religion.

And stoop and build 'em up with worn-out tools:

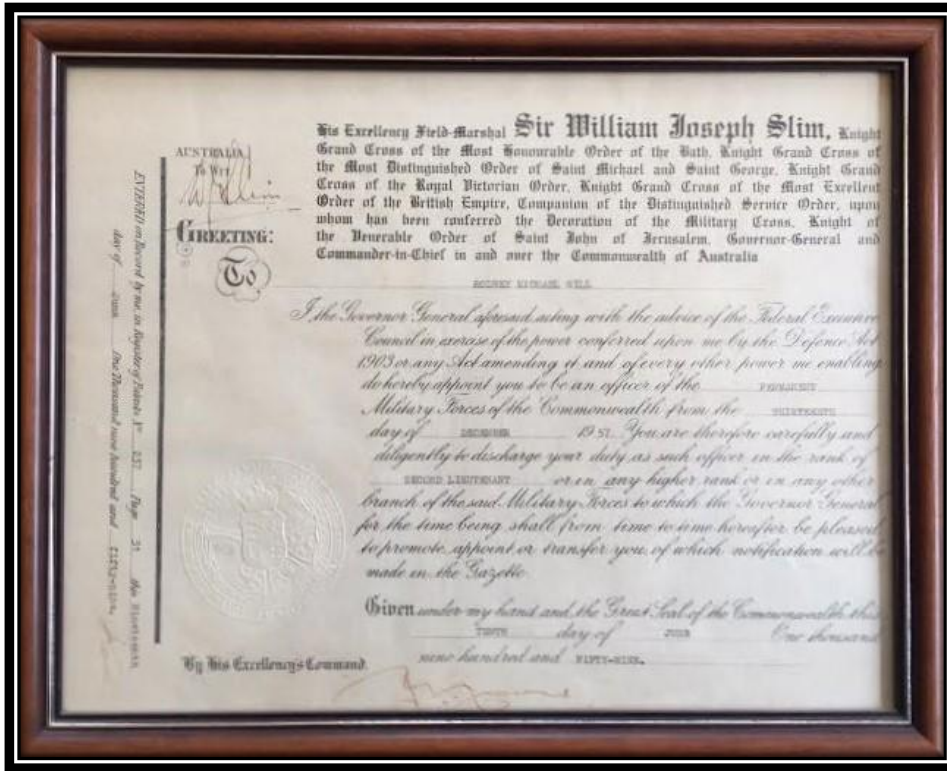
If you can make one heap of all your winnings

And - which is more - you'll be a Man, my son!



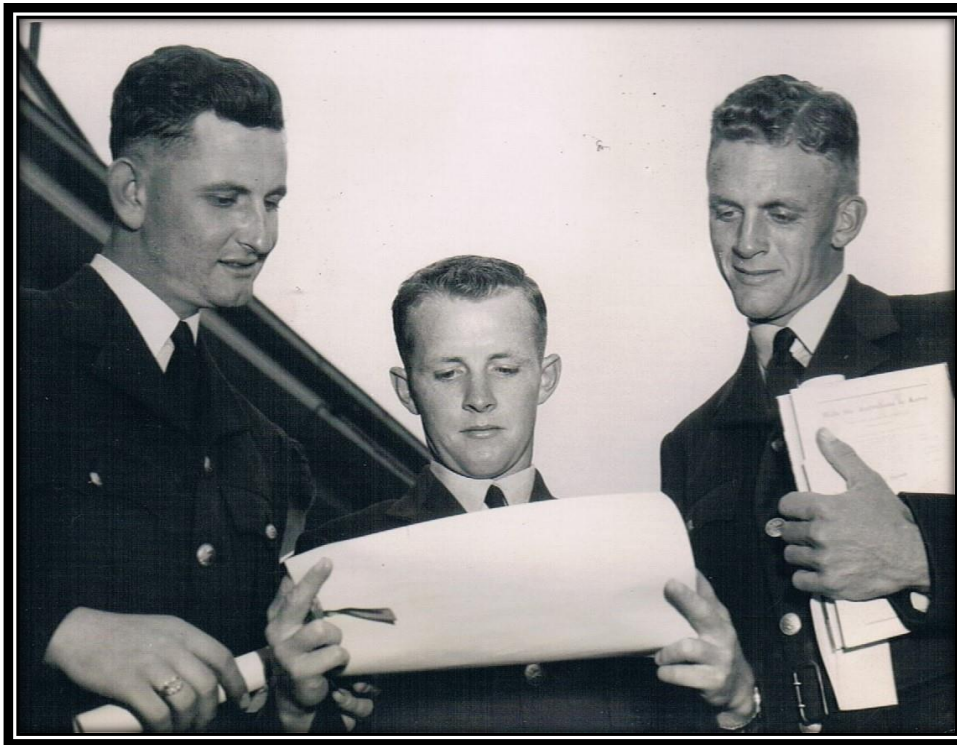

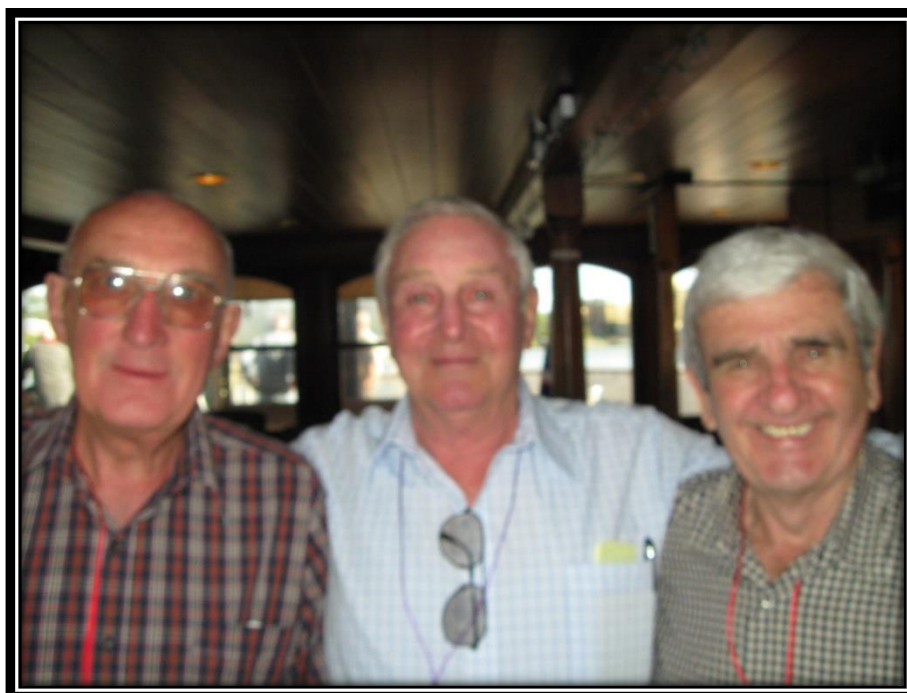
