



OCS ~ EARLY PREDICTIONS/FINAL RESULTS

When OCS commenced training officer cadets in January 1952, the early classes were informed that promotion prospects could be expected to attain the rank of Major in the Australian Regular Army. Probably not much thought was given to this possibility by these classes as the immediate aim of every cadet concentrated on finishing the course and graduating as a Second Lieutenant. However, as Graduates gained more experience, this early prediction probably entered the minds of those that were subject to it. Time would tell and tell it did!

Promotion of Graduates from 1952 to 1959 tells a very different story from the stated outcome. Many Graduates were promoted above the rank of Major. The following list indicates *only* those Graduates who achieved one star (Brigadier) and the very first two star (Major General) levels, all within the first decade. So much for the early predictions!

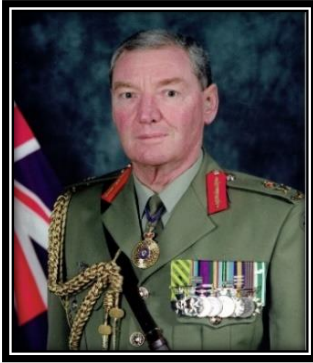
OCS's early classes, however, foreshadowed the trend in ranks when the following first decade (1952 to 1959) promotions to one or two star level occurred:

- Brig Mike Holton, CSC – OCS Class of Jun '59,
- Brig Ron Boxall – OCS Class of Dec '59, and finally OCS's first two-star graduate in
- Maj Gen David McLachlan, AO – OCS Class of Dec '59.

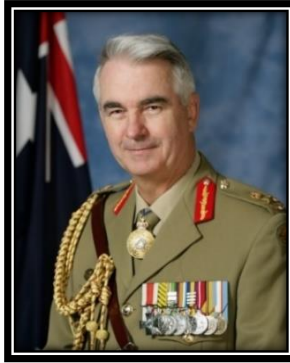
Thus the trend for OCS graduates was set. Many more achieved ranks above the early predicted rank level with fourteen achieving either Lieutenant General (3) or Major General rank (11). (*See Photo Gallery*). OCS Graduates found their place as important leaders in the Australian Army.

The same can be said of its thirty RAAF Graduates, with one attaining Air Commodore rank (John Meier ~ OCS Class of Jun '80) and another who achieved Group Captain level, the latter entering politics and holding the Speaker in the Commonwealth House of Representatives (Bob Halverson ~ OCS Class of Jun '57). Bob also became the Ambassador to Ireland and the Holy See post politics. International Graduates also achieved high ranks in their respective Defence Forces. (*See Photo Gallery*).

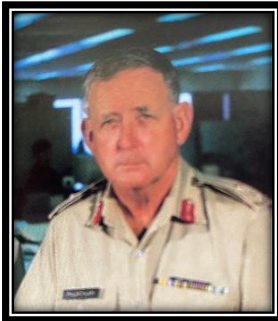

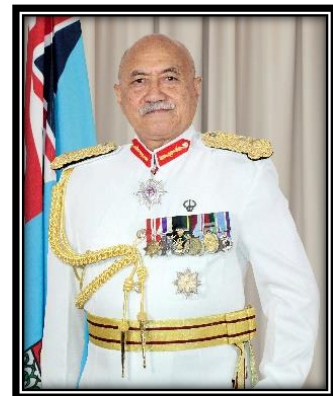

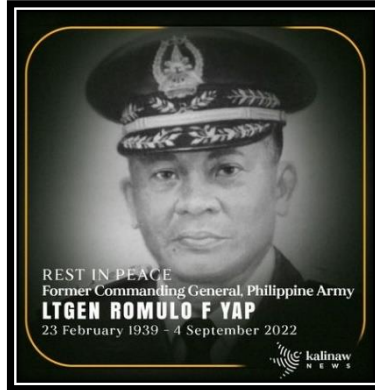
